'HE MAKES ME LIE DOWN IN GREEN PASTURES'

When we say or sing Psalm 23, we doubtless have a mental picture of lush green paddocks, dotted with sheep. In Palestine, however, sheep are not usually seen on farm lands, needed for growing crops. In April 1994, in very well-spaced isolation, our forty course members spent a silent hour meditating in the desert off the Jerusalem-Jericho road, getting the 'feel' of the desert. Bare whitish rocks and pebbles everywhere. Absolute silence. One spindly tree. Then, briefly, a fragile bird song. But a shepherd sat there on a rock, watching his few sheep and goats rambling, grazing on grass invisible to us. Single grass plants well scattered - just enough for the day's food. Is this how we should re-see Psalm 23? Joan
