Joining in to Worship with Zoom.

Well done to everyone who joined in to Rosalie's farewell service by Zoom – we all managed very well for our first experience of live streaming a service using this technology.

It was wonderful to see all those who joined in from 9am and were able to 'see' each other and catch up after all these weeks of isolation. It was also very good to see that folk who do not have access to the internet or have the appropriate equipment were invited to visit the home of someone who does so that they were able to participate in the service as well.

We plan to continue using this process each week, and the service will also be posted to Facebook as it has been for those who wish to catch up with it at a later time.

There are a few things to remember as we use Zoom.

- A new link will be sent out with the News each week. Click on the blue, underlined list of letters and numbers under the heading "Join Zoom Meeting" then click on 'join with video' and 'join with audio'.
- To view everyone in the worship select **Gallery view**, to see the church in full screen or who is speaking select **Speaker View**.
- Zoom will open at 9am each Sunday so that those joining in can have a time of fellowship prior to the Service.
- The hosts will 'mute' everyone 5 minutes before worship begins and a slide inviting participants to prepare for worship will be displayed.
- Please DO NOT unmute yourself during Worship as this interrupts the transmission from the Church and everyone can hear your conversation!
 - If you are doing a reading or prayer from home via Zoom, the host at the Church will unmute you at the appropriate time.
- Be aware that the video camera on your computer, ipad or phone will transmit everything you are doing to everyone else who is watching.
- Loni reminds us that we are participating in Worship, in a new way that this is not an entertainment...

Step 1: To join the meeting via a Phone call please dial one of the five following phone numbers: The 03 number is for Victoria so is likely to be a cheaper call than one of the interstate numbers.

Step 2: when prompted enter the meeting code on the Zoom invitation. This will change each week,

The Meeting Code for the 6th of September is **914 7004 6686**

followed by the hash key #

Step 3: you will asked if you are the meeting host or a participant

Don't worry about this question, just press #

Step 4: when prompted enter the passcode on the Zoom invitation, which will also change each week.

The Passcode for the $6^{\rm th}$ of September is 115573 followed by the hash key #
