#### **OLIVE HARVEST IN PALESTINE 2020**

In this beautiful land where Jesus' ministry took place, olive trees can live and produce fruit for hundreds of years.

We've been invited to pray for this year's olive harvest in Palestine's Occupied Territories. This is why *our prayers are needed*: Covid-19 has prevented the entrance of internationals to Israel-Palestine since March 2020. Ecumenical Accompaniers would usually be there now, providing protective presence and documenting any incidents.

The U.N. Office for the Co-ordination of Humanitarian Affairs reports that from 1 Jan. 2020 – 13<sup>th</sup> Oct. 2020, there were *547 incidents* of attack or trespass against Palestinians by illegal Israeli settlers in the West Bank. This included *5650 olive trees* being vandalised. Members of the Israeli military who are witness to such events protect settlers, not Palestinian farmers on their own land. And sadly, Israeli authorities fail to properly investigate such offences: 90% of investigations are dropped without indictments. Please pray for a just resolution. *Joan Fisher*
