REPORT OF THE OCTOBER CHURCH COUNCIL MEETING

Church Council met on the 14th of October, 2020, yet again by Zoom.

Church Council was delighted to approve the recommendation that the Rev Glenys Gill be invited to provide Supply Ministry in the Shepparton Congregation, initially from the 1st of November, 2020 until the 31st of January 2021, for 2 days each week. Glenys will provide pastoral care and will lead worship on one Sunday each month.

Rev Loni Vaitohi will take leave from the $15^{th} - 22^{nd}$ of November, 2020 and from the $17^{th} - 24^{th}$ of January 2021. Loni expressed his sincere thanks to Rev Joan Fisher for her support and collegiality over the last few months and also thanked the IT team and others involved in the weekly streaming of our worship services.

The Presbytery of North East Victoria,in partnership with Pilgrim Theological College, have been exploring ways in which congregations within the Presbytery might host Theological students for a field placement during this time of Covid with its regulations around movement and gathering. The Church Council agreed that an Expression of Interest be submitted for the Shepparton Congregation to host a student for a field placement. We will be notified during November if we will be hosting a student.

Reports were received from the Property Maintenance Committee and the Presbytery Property, Finance and Administration Committee regarding the Loddon Court Manse and the amount of work required to bring it up to the standard required by Synod. Further discussion will take place and a recommendation will be presented in due course.

A letter was received from the RSL inviting the Congregation to lay a wreath on Remembrance Day. Due to the Covid restrictions the Service will not be attended by the general public so the Wreath will be laid by an RSL Committee member on our behalf. Jeni Fitzgerald will organise the wreath.

The Uniting team are very happy in the front meeting room. They are advertising their presence with tear drop signs and a new, fixed sign will be erected shortly. Due to the Covid restrictions there are only two staff members present at any one time.

Valuations of the Maude Street Property have been carried out as approved at the September CC meeting. The reports are yet to be received.

ALL SAINTS, ALL SOULS, ALLHALLOWSTIDE

From early times, the Church honoured those who had been martyred for their faith. A feast day for All Martyrs and All Saints developed when there were more than 365 of each! The date was moved but has been on November 1 since 835. Allhallowstide included All Hallows' Eve, All Saints (hallows) and All Souls. Originally, and still in some places, services were held on All Hallows, including the lighting of candles on graves. The division between the Saints and other faithful departed (Souls) who were honoured on November 2, is not usually kept in Protestant churches who remember all faithful departed, including Saints on November 1. And the evening of October 31 is now remembered differently! This year, without our Memorial Service, you might like to light a candle for your loved ones now part of the Communion of Saints gathered before God's throne. J
