## **NEWS FROM THE 16TH ASSEMBLY**

Revd Sharon Hollis was installed as President of the Uniting Church in Australia on Saturday, July 17, receiving the symbols of office from Ex-President Dr Deirdre Palmer. Sharon is the third woman and first ordained woman to become President. Later in the two-day online Assembly, members voted for the President-Elect from three women nominees. The President-Elect is Rev Charissa Suli, a Second Generation Tongan, ordained in 2014, and still in her 'thirties. The term of the Assembly General Secretary, Colleen Geyer, was extended for 3.5 years. For the next three years, the entire Uniting Church leadership team - Ex-President, President, President-Elect and General Secretary - are all women! (The Associate General Secretary, however, is Rob Floyd.) At present, only two other national churches have women heads - the Society of Friends and the Samoan Congregational Church. (In her 44 years, the Uniting Church has had many distinguished women leaders of the Assembly and Synods.)

Ps Mark Kickett brought a report from Congress and, using video, shared stories about relationship, culture and faith from our First Peoples. Greetings were brought, online, from our Partner Churches around the world.

Sunday's Bible Reflections were led by staff and students from Nungalinya College, Darwin. Speaking from their own cultural and theological perspectives, they reflected on the Assembly theme, *Dwelling in Love*.

Monday 26 will be our seventh night to offer hospitality to the homeless on behalf of this Congregation. The project for 2021 has now completed six weeks, the halfway point. Although there have recently been several new Guests, we continued with three, who greatly enjoy sharing our hospitality. Their sense of security and wellbeing has increased; this is especially so of our newest guest. Meanwhile the Volunteers have become a very experienced and well-honed team, all polishing their skills to welcome and provide hospitality and care for the Guests. The brilliant catering is another feature of Monday nights! We started offering sandwiches for our Guests' lunches but now are able to pack them another dinner which they are able to heat at the Salvation Army next day - except for one who prefers to take just two muesli bars. Uniting's Job Search assistance has continued; one of our Guests is almost ready for employment. When did you last read a book from the shelves in the narthex? The shelves and the narthex table are sources of reading material each week for some of our Guests as well as our Volunteers. The notice boards are scanned for anything new. Providing this is part of the congregation's mission, of course!
