REFLECTION

There are so many claimants to the truth these days. Some say, for instance, that climate change is rapidly having an effect on our planet, while there are still some who say it's all rubbish. In the lead up to this year's Federal election, people on all sides of politics were trying to convince us that truth lay with them. In a religious context, acoss the world different groups of people are convinced that God is on their side, and that truth can only rest with their particular dogma.

Where is the truth in all this? How confusing it all is.

Because the truth is so difficult to discern in many of life's situations, wouldn't it be useful to have a guide to assist us. There is such a guide that we have encountered in the pages of the scriptures, and hopefully in life as well. Jesus is one who can be trusted to assist us. When he lived on earth, he seemed to know the truth about people — the Samaritan woman at the well who had five husbands, for instance, or Zaccheus, the little guy who cheated people. And knowing the truth, Jesus helped many people move beyond the issues they couldn't or wouldn't face in the present, and unlock their true potential. No matter the reality, Jesus knew - and could handle - the truth about people.

Further, Jesus represented all that was true. Many world religions know the teachings of Jesus and claim him as a great moral teacher. Jesus spoke the truth about life.

How easy it would be to turn to someone like this and ask: what is the truth? If Jesus were here, among us still, he could answer the difficult questions of the day and give us guidance. He could explain his life and his ultimate purpose. He could tell us now, in his own words - not words that have been translated, interpreted, or paraphrased - the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth about himself and the world.

Clearly, we don't have Jesus with us in such a physical sense, and he cannot speak directly for himself. We have his words contained in the scriptures, but even these are open to interpretation.

The verses we read today from John chapter 16 tell us that Jesus knew the truth would be difficult to determine after he had left the scene. "I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you in all truth" (16:12). It is as if the disciples were saying, "We want the truth," and Jesus replies, "You can't handle the truth, yet.".

So, Jesus sent another person, a third part of the person of God, the Holy Spirit, to be that ongoing witness.

Advocate, Comforter, Spirit of Truth, Wisdom, Spirit of God, Holy Spirit, wind, breath, fire – across our Bible and within our Christian traditions, we experience many aspects of the Spirit. From before Earth, as we know it, was formed, and during the genesis, God's Spirit was present. Wisdom is in Creation, comforting compassionately, informing righteousness, at the heart of justice, breathing peace into troubled spaces, interceding, advocating, and imparting ways to express ourselves when we alone cannot find a way. As Jesus' earthly mission concluded, he breathed the Spirit into the lives of the disciples. Later, the Spirit's presence transformed a gathering of unlikely acquaintances through a Pentecost of renewal, connecting them through living faith and God's love.

Now, Jesus says to us: "You now have the Counselor, the Spirit of truth so that nothing will remain hidden and all things will be revealed." We are given this wonderful gift, so that even in the absence of the physical witness of Jesus, we can listen to the Counselor and hear the truth that can change the heart and transform the world. Thanks be to God. Amen
