Sermon Brief: 'Boundaries'

- Boundaries are necessary to keep us safe, to protect us, and to identify who we are.
- There are many boundaries that define us also as a community like geographical boundaries, social and cultural boundaries, moral and ethical boundaries etc.
- Boundaries can also be exclusive, disputed, abused and often used as an excuse to victimise.
- Our gospel reading for today (Luke 9: 51-62) tells us of how Jesus navigates himself through and respond to boundaries that divides, excludes and disempower people.



- First, his face was set towards Jerusalem where he would be crucified for the salvation of the world.
- In this context of setting his face towards Jerusalem, he went through Samaria both a geographical and ethnic boundary which a Jew is not supposed to do.
- Jews were required to avoid all contact with these "lowlife" who had the temerity to believe that they also worship God from their temple just as the Jews do from the Temple in Jerusalem.
- That boundary between the Jews and the Samaritans are highlighted by James and John seeing the Samaritans disrespect asked Jesus if they could call down judgement on those folks.
- Jesus showed here that the only judgement to come from heaven is Jesus himself. What he is doing and will continue to do is God's judgement for the salvation of all.
- The boundary of age, as Jesus indicated the kingdom of God is for children too.
- What are the boundaries that we need to keep, and which are those that we need to be careful of lest we use them to abuse, disempower, exclude and victimise?
- We are mindful of what is happening between the Ukraine and Russia, between ethnic communities in Sri Lanka, between Indonesia and West Papua etc.
- Jesus offers an alternative LOVING!
- Look at the boundaries that God transcends and redefined for our sake.
- He was born of a virgin, the King as servant of all, died on a cross with thieves, buried in a stranger's grave he came to his own but they did not recognise him, he was the good shepherd for he was the lamb that was slain.
- Even the boundary of death cannot stop him from saving the world. He ROSE!

Service of Baptism

Christopher and Laura Crouch have come today to present their sons Jackson Brian Crouch and Brodie Ian Crouch for baptism.

(Minister)

Hear the words of the Lord Jesus Christ:

All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.

Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them all that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, to the close of the age.

The meaning of baptism:

Obeying the word of the Lord Jesus, and confident of his promises, the church baptises those whom he has called.

Baptism is sign of new life in Christ Jesus.

By water and the Holy Spirit, we are brought into union with Christ in his death and resurrection.

In baptism we are sealed with the Holy Spirit, made members of the body of Christ, and called to his ministry in the world.

Renunciation and Affirmation:

Christopher and Laura, what do you ask of God's church for Jackson and Brodie? We ask that they be baptised into the faith and family of Jesus Christ.



In the light of the covenant promise and of your request, I ask you now:

Do you believe that the gospel enables us to turn from the darkness of evil and to walk in the light of Christ? **We do.**

Jackson Brian Crouch may the Lord open your ears to receive his word, and your mouth to proclaim his praise. Brodie Ian Crouch may the Lord open your ears to receive his word, and your mouth to proclaim his praise.

Let us confess the faith into which we are baptised. (*The congregation stand*)

Do you believe in God, who made you and loves you?

I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

Do you believe in Jesus Christ, your Saviour and Lord?
I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord,
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,
born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate,
was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to the dead.
On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven,
he is seated at the right hand of the Father,
and he will come to judge the living and the dead.

Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, and the continuing work of our salvation? I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, and the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen,

be raised to new life in Christ, and continue to be his faithful disciples; through Jesus Christ our Lord, to whom with you and the Holy Spirit be all honour and glory, now and for ever.

As you have loved them from the beginning, continue to protect and guide them.

May they become loyal disciples of Jesus Christ.
